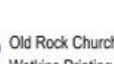

This rule applies to all large pools, whether they are above or below ground. Small kiddie pools are exempt from the enclosure requirement.

A Word From Public Works

The school year is fast approaching and with that, we will soon be painting cross-walks. Please be aware and drive with caution as our crew is painting and do not drive through or move the cones. The cones will be removed once the paint is dry.

We have received calls about the chip sealing that has taken place on some of the streets throughout the city. Callers wonder "why the city ruined their new, smooth road with chips." As much as we all might dislike chip seal, especially right after the chips have been put down, this is one of the best ways to maximize the life of a road, so we chip seal new asphalt within a year of the asphalt being put down. Our goal is to maintain the city streets as best we can. Even though chip sealing isn't the newest, cutting edge technology, it is very affordable and does a great job preserving the life of our streets. We have started sweeping up the excess chips, then will put down a fog seal, which is a liquid coating that will finish the process. Hopefully this answers some questions, and rest assured we are not purposefully "ruining" any of our city streets.

The city will be contracting out our annual street striping. The striping will be scheduled after all of the chipping and HA5 treatments have been completed. Please use caution when in the area of the striping.

Please do not leave grass clippings in the curb and gutter. This has the potential to cause flooding, so please help keep the water ways clear.
