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
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## A. General Setback Requirements

- 7. Retaining Walls.
  - a. Less than three feet (3') in height. Retaining walls less than three feet (3') in height are exempt from setback requirements. See illustration 6.
  - b. Three feet (3') to six feet (6') in height. Retaining walls from three feet (3') to six feet (6') in height may be located within a required non-street side or rear setback area in residential zones and any setback area in nonresidential zones provided the exposed side of the wall faces into the subject parcel. See illustrations 2, 4, 5.

Walls in the graphic are shown on the applicant's property.



- c. Greater than six feet (6') in height. Rear and non-street side setbacks for retaining walls greater that six feet (6') in height, or where the exposed side of the wall faces out from the subject parcel, is three feet in height or greater, shall be subject to the same requirements as the main structure in the applicable zoning district. See illustration 1 & 7.
- d. See Chapter 5-4 Fence Regulations of this code for additional retaining wall regulations.

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
